

18 Ft Two Tier Roof Kit

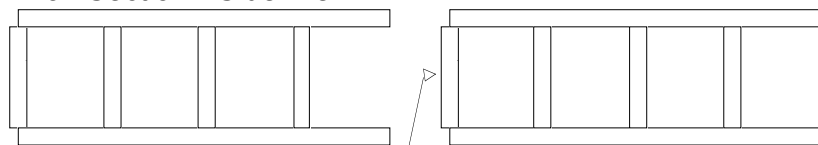
Materials List

12 - Wall Sections	1 - Roof Peak
12 - Roofing Plywood	1 - Screen
12 - Fascia Boards	1 - Bag of 1 ½" Box Nails
12 - Rafters	1 - Bag of 1 ½" Finishing Nails
12 - Bug Boards	1 - Bag of 2 ½" #2 Robertson Head Screws

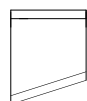
Instructions For Assembly:

1. Lay out the wall sections on a flat surface. Nail the walls together, making sure that the angled part of the wall is down.
1. Install the screen stapling it fast to the inside of the wall.
1. Next, take two rafters and screw them to the roof peak. Place the two rafters on the top of the wall plates across the walls diagonally at the wall joints. Make sure the center of the rafters line up with the wall joints. If the notch does not fit snugly, push the wall in or out or lift the roof peak up until it does. Fasten securely to the wall. Attach the remaining rafters to the roof peak and wall, making sure to keep rafters tight against each other around the roof peak. Also be sure to keep the notch at the bottom of the rafter tight against the wall. (At this point, you may take the two tier roof and place it on the gazebo roof; or you may chose to wait until later).
1. Install the Bug Boards to the top of each wall plate keeping them flush with the top of the rafter.
1. Install fascia boards, making sure that the joints are aligned. The fascia should be flush with the top of the rafter.
1. If you are planning to open part of your gazebo roof for ventilation, you will need to do so at this point.
1. If you didn't place the two tier roof on your gazebo before, do so now. Attach to the gazebo roof.
1. Shingle the roof with your choice of shingles.

Each wall has one stud that extends past the end of the plate, which fastens to the other end of the adjoining wall.
